- Resolving ICB information governance issues regarding specialised data, development of DPIA if required
- Receiving and reconciling 23/24 allocations with providers
- Integrating specialised data into existing ICB reporting environments
- Coordinating and supporting development of ICB reports to track specialised activity and spend, and modelling actual ICB spend in relation to planned ICB budget
- Developing understanding of specialised data quality issues, particularly those regarding ICB and service line allocation
- Supporting financial intelligence colleagues with in-depth data quality analysis, including monitoring of Identification Rules (IR)
- Calculating impact of future changes in allocations (i.e. shift to needs-based)
